READING OVERVIEW

As you know, the reading will be held in a beautiful hall at the historic Saint Joseph's Cultural Center in Grass Valley, and COW alum Maxima Kahn will be our MC.

As we have in the past, we will have a book sale, signing, and reception after the event.

TRAVEL PLANS: (Let me know if anything is changing here)

-Brenda and Jane will drive up together.

-Forrest will pick up David at the airport.

-Greg is picking up a rental car when he lands.

ARRIVAL AND LOCATION:

First of all: It is and will be fairly warm here (forecast 86--last year was 95 for reference), so please plan accordingly. The reading venue is an old historic building but it DOES have air conditioning, so the temperature inside should be pretty pleasant.

You can check in at the Grass Valley Courtyard Suites at 3pm (Saturday, check out is 11am). If you arrive sooner, they may be able to check you in sooner--just ask. 210 North Auburn Street, Grass Valley. I have confirmed your reservations earlier this week and all is well. The hotel has a bar and lounge that are open all day, so if you get there before check in and they can't check you in early, you can leave your bags at the front desk and have a snack or drink at the hotel until your room is ready. Please gather at Saint Joseph's (410 S. Church Street, Grass Valley, CA 95945) by 6pm. The reading will start promptly at 7pm. The doors open at 6:00 for the public, so if you'd prefer to come earlier so you aren't in that swarm, feel welcome. (However, please arrive no later than 6:30.) We have a private air-conditioned green room area for you with snacks (cheese/crackers/fruit), water, and wine (please let me know ASAP if you have allergies or other food issues so I can be sure to work around those). There is parking in front of the venue, and just down the street behind the venue. There will be signs directing you to parking (and probably a volunteer out in the front of the venue as well) so you should have no problem finding a place. When you arrive, please text me or look for me. We will also have our eyes out for you so we can escort you to the green room.

FLOW OF THE EVENING:

Our emcee for the evening, Maxima Kahn, will speak briefly about the Community of Writers, thank the volunteers, and then introduce Community of Writers alum Judy Crowe, who will read a poem or two from her new book. After that, Maxima will introduce the first of you to read. Then each of you will each read for approx 12 minutes.
